### **ROAD RULES**

- Make sure your bike is mechanically ready and arrive FFEB (fed, fueled and empty bladder).
- Arrive well before the posted leaving time to hear any last minute changes and directions from your Road Captain.
- Never pass the Road Captain. He/she has been given the responsibility to lead the group.
- Stay in the same lane as the Road Captain, riding in a staggered formation where appropriate-never side by side.
- On winding roads, corner as you normally would, allowing plenty of room for the other riders.
- Keep to the road speed limits; regularly checking the person behind you is in view.
- Always signal your intention to change lanes; keeping a safe distance behind the rider in front.
- **DON'T DRINK AND RIDE**

**\*\*The officers of JAXHOG wish to pass along the reminder that *Riding Safe* is our primary goal. As a result, the consumption of alcohol before or during any Chapter sponsored ride is strictly prohibited. If you drink before or during a Chapter ride, you will be asked to leave the group and ride on your own.**

## Safety Talk

### Hydration and warm weather riding.

Following is portions of an Allstate article on Safe Motorcycle riding.

With the oncoming high temperatures and humidity of summer motorcycle riders need to take a little extra care to keep their mind and body tuned-up to deal with the heat.

One easily preventable and often overlooked motorcycle safety hazard on the road is dehydration.

What is Dehydration?

In simple terms, dehydration is using more water than your body is taking in. This means you don't need to be running a marathon for dehydration to set in. The act of riding your motorcycle in the heat can be a cause. Spending hours in the saddle under the hot sun without replenishing your fluids can be a recipe for disaster.

### Symptoms of dehydration: Headache, Weakness, Dry Mouth & Increased Thirst

Do you feel a little "off"? Listen to your body. The dizziness or sluggishness a motorcycle rider may experience as a result of not taking in enough fluids can have dire consequences.

Often, your body may be experiencing mild dehydration before common symptoms begin to appear. With a small amount of extra planning before you get on your bike, you can keep your body strong and your mind sharp for the duration of your ride.

Having adequate stops during your ride can give your body a few moments to rest. Pick a nice, shady spot and enjoy the scenery while you recharge your battery.

Water is the best option for keeping your body hydrated. A sports drink is also a good choice. Alcoholic beverages like wine and beer as well as caffeinated beverages like soda, coffee and teas are diuretics and actually encourage fluid loss. They should be avoided to keep your motor

running in tiptop shape.

Ride Smart – Ride Safe. Don't leave your personal safety to chance during the coming dog days of summer. Leave home prepared with something to drink along the way.

And don't forget to use the sunscreen & lip balm.

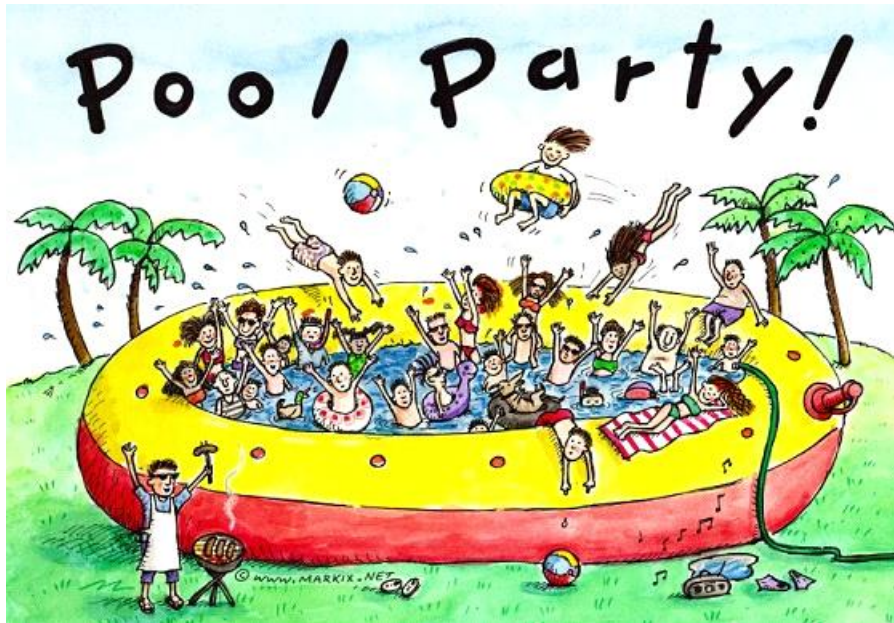

No Chapter member or guest may operate a motorcycle at a Chapter event or activity unless that person is LEGALLY LICENSED TO DO SO AND HIS/HER MOTORCYCLE IS PROPERLY REGISTERED AND INSURED. Members and guests are hereby also notified that they participate in any and all Chapter activities, events, rides, runs, and/or meetings AT THEIR OWN RISK. ALL EVENTS END UPON ARRIVAL AT THE DESTINATION. ALL EVENTS ARE ALCOHOL-FREE.
