

### Chapter Member Enrollment Form and Release

We've been doing 2017 early enrollment since October. A great way to beat the crowd and save a few dollars. Those dollars can be used towards purchasing some more HD items. You can never get too much Harley stuff.

The "Chapter Member Enrollment Form and Release" must be signed by each member on an annual basis (January 1). Each new member must sign the Chapter enrollment/release when they join the Chapter and on an annual basis (January 1) thereafter.

### Chapter Release Form for Minors

The law treats minors differently than adults. Adults may sign an annual release form only for themselves, not for their minor children. A minor who is a Chapter member must still have a parent or legal guardian sign the "Chapter Event Release Form for Minors" whenever a minor participates in any Chapter event other than a Chapter meeting even if the minor is a member of the Chapter. If the minor is aged 12 or above, the minor must also sign the "Minor's Assumption of Risk Acknowledgement." Both forms are to be signed at the same time and kept together as separate pages of one document.

### Photographic Material


Every HOG Chapter that publishes photographic material in any format is solely responsible for obtaining the proper permissions and licenses. Harley-Davidson discourages HOG Chapters from publishing and photographs of minor children, even with the permission from a parent or guardian.

### Releases – Condition of Insurance Coverage

In order to be covered by the Harley Owners Group Chapter Insurance Program, signed releases must be obtained from all event participants. (Adult members with annual releases on file do not have to sign a day of event release when attending their own Chapter closed events. When in doubt, get the release signed). Minors (members or not) need releases every time. All releases must be stored in a safe place for seven (7) years.

Ride Safe and Have Fun. Don't forget the hydration, sunscreen and lip balm.

## Safety

Earl Higginbotham, Safety

There is a bit of a daredevil in all of us – otherwise we wouldn't be riding motorcycles. Daredevils can still ride responsibly. As mentioned in last month's meeting, using your 2-4-12 seconds should always be a part of your riding every time! As a part of your anticipation time, looking ahead 12 seconds, you should be thinking about your escape path.

You start with providing yourself plenty of margin between you and other vehicles; the less margin, the more risk. Your margin provides adequate space cushion to brake and/or swerve. You must have time and space to maneuver.

Recall from your basic rider course, you should avoid target fixation so you do not crash into what you are staring at. You may have heard the saying, "You ride where you look." – this can be a good thing, such as going through a curve OR a bad thing, staring at a car. Use your 12 seconds to always look for your escape-path options. The escape path will hopefully never be needed, but allows you to avoid a collision. An escape path can nearly be anything – an emergency lane, the shoulder or median or perhaps even a quick stop (always check behind you!).

Personally, riding to work in traffic a lot, I create multiple escape paths for busy intersections I encounter on my route to work. Anticipating scenarios make you more aware which obviously translates into a safer rider!

### ROAD RULES

- Make sure your bike is mechanically ready and arrive FFEB (fed, fueled and empty bladder).
- Arrive well before the posted leaving time to hear any last minute changes and directions from your Road Captain.

- Always signal your intention to change lanes; keeping a safe distance behind the rider in front.

No Chapter member or guest may operate a motorcycle at a Chapter event or activity unless that person is LEGALLY LICENSED TO DO SO AND HIS/HER MOTORCYCLE IS PROPERLY REGISTERED AND INSURED. Members and guests are hereby also notified that they participate in any and all Chapter activities, events, rides, runs, and/or meetings AT THEIR OWN RISK. ALL EVENTS END UPON ARRIVAL AT THE DESTINATION. ALL EVENTS ARE ALCOHOL-FREE.


