ROAD RULES

- Make sure your bike is mechanically ready and arrive FFEB (fed, fueled and empty bladder).
- Arrive well before the posted leaving time to hear any last minute changes and directions from your Road Captain.
- Never pass the Road Captain. He/she has been given the responsibility to lead the group.
- Stay in the same lane as the Road Captain, riding in a staggered formation where appropriate-never side by side.
- On winding roads, corner as you normally would, allowing plenty of room for the other riders.
- Keep to the road speed limits; regularly checking the person behind you is in view.
- Always signal your intention to change lanes;
 keeping a safe distance behind the rider in front.
- DON'T DRINK AND RIDE

With red, white and blue banners lining the entrance to **Brookdale Avondale Senior Living**, 35 motorcyclists from the Jacksonville Harley Owners Group, Chapter No. 0681, arrived to take three residents on a 10-mile ride.

"They were ecstatic, and there was a very good vibe in the air," said **Andy Cooper**, historian of the chapter, known as Jax HOG and sponsored by Adamec Harley Davidson.

He said the women had never ridden on a Harley before. A 93-year-old rode with director **Hart Sutton**, an 80-year-old with **Patrick Porter** and a staff member who is battling cancer with **Rick Kirtley**. Sporting big smiles, they enjoyed "feeling the power and excitement of riding on a Harley Davidson motorcycle," Cooper said.

Safety Talk

THE NO ZONE

There is a specific dimension defined that which is known to man. It is a dimension as vast as a car and has a dangerous specificity. It is the spaces in front, sides and rear of the tractor-trailers on the road. If you ride there it can cause fear, but can be overcome with this knowledge. This is the dimension of potential catastrophe. It is an area, which we call ... The No Zone.

To get the full effect of my introduction paragraph you would have read it in your best Rod Serling voice. Feel free to go back later and try again. But, looking forward to the rest of this month's article, I would like to take a moment and share information about The No Zone.

The No Zone is a marketing campaign term for what is more commonly known as the blind spot for semi-trailer trucks. It has been determined there are certain areas around the cab and trailer of the large vehicle where your vehicle can seem to disappear from the sight of the truck driver.

Because of this, it's important for you to know where these zones are for the truck driver and make yourself safer by not lingering in the No Zone. They say, "loud pipes saves lives," but it is extremely important to be seen by truck drivers.

Where is the No Zone you may ask? The picture included defines these areas. Even with the best mirrors, a truck driver cannot gain visibility of these areas. Some simple tips to know if you are or are not in the No Zone are – if you cannot see:

- the driver in the truck's mirror, he or she cannot see you.
- both of the truck's headlights in your mirrors... yep, they cannot see you.
- the left and right side mirrors of the truck, then you are probably following too closely to the truck.

My article has focused primarily on large tractortrailers and their drivers, but really the No Zone exists for buses and cars as well. Lastly, when you are riding and having fun, do not forget to make sure everyone sees you doing it!

P.S. – As a special treat and to help you experience the No Zone first hand, we have arranged for a truck to be parked in the back parking lot of Adamec. You will be able to hop up into the cab of the truck and see how the bikes parked in the No Zone disappear!

Rated (3) More challenging ride in distance, speed, time, and roads. Ride may be during hours of daylight or darkness. Moderate to highway speeds. Occasional to infrequent stops. Interstate, primary and secondary roads.

The JAXHOG Story

The goals of the Jacksonville, Florida Chapter Harley Owners Group #0681 (JAXHOG) are to promote motorcycling activities for Harley-Davidson motorcycle owners who belong to the Harley Owners Group (H.O.G.) and to enjoy the camaraderie and friendship through a variety of social and private gatherings, events and activities. They must identify themselves to the Road Captain, Event Coordinator, or Chapter Director (or Designate) and submit a SIGNED RELEASE FORM prior to the start of a ride/event. No Chapter member or guest may operate a motorcycle at a Chapter event or activity unless that person is LEGALLY LICENSED TO DO SO AND HIS/HER MOTORCYCLE IS PROPERLY REGISTERED AND INSURED. Members and guests are hereby also notified that they participate in any and all Chapter activities, events, rides, runs, and/or meetings AT THEIR OWN RISK. ALL EVENTS END UPON ARRIVAL AT THE DESTINATION. ALL EVENTS ARE ALCOHOL-FREE.
